This Addendum 1 has been crafted to clarify the distinction between the District's existing Specialty Waste Program and the new Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Program associated with this RFP.

1. The Medina County Solid Waste District currently collects a variety of "Specialty Wastes" for recycling. The District currently manages through separate processor relationships the following materials:

- Scrap tires
- Used coil
- Cooking oil
- Antifreeze
- Lead acid batteries
- All other types of batteries
- Compact fluorescent bulbs
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Household propane style tanks
- Electronic equipment
- Mobile devices

The Household Hazardous Waste Contractor will not be required to manage these Specialty Waste materials. HHW Bidders are welcome to present a price for these items to be managed outboard of the HHW Proposal process. Specialty Waste Processors are welcome to contact the District directly to discuss opportunities for managing any of the Specialty Wastes.

Page 6 of 24 of the HHW RFP documents states

"Basic Requirements of HHW Collection Program

Attachment A includes all the materials acceptable in the District's HHW program. The HHW contractor is expected to provide transportation, disposal and recycling for the HHW materials listed in the pricing sheet in Attachment B. The District has certain local and regional contracts for disposal and recycling of scrap tires, used oil, cooking oil, antifreeze, lead acid batteries, compact fluorescent bulbs, fluorescent bulbs, household propane style tanks, household batteries and electronic equipment and mobile devices. The HHW contract will not be responsible for these materials but some of these categories are included in Attachment B as an option for the District."
